



Death Valley Road Stage Race

August 27-28, 2011 **55 miles 13400' climbing**
Big Pine & Independence, CA

WE RACE RAIN OR SHINE! OR SNOW! Sorry, but No Refunds!

Stage 1 42 miles 8200' of climbing

Stage 2 13 miles 5200' of climbing

One day license (Men5, Women4 ONLY), annual USAC license available at signin

Stage 1 Sign-In 6:00 – 7:30AM Saturday junction of CA168 and Death Valley Rd, just east of US395 in Big Pine, CA. Two big climbs with summit finish.

THREE Aid Stations with water, HEED, ECaps, Clif bars, etc. Bottle handups. Self-support, so carry tube and CO2/pump. Food and drinks at the finish both days.

Stage 2 Check In 6:30 – 7:30AM Sunday at Independence Park at the south end of town in Independence, CA. One long climb, summit finish. Aid Station at summit.

Do this race self-supported! Not a USAC racer? Enter as Cat 5 (Cat 4 for Women!) with one day license and ride at your own pace. **Held under USA Cycling event permit, and permitted by Inyo County.**

You must finish Stage 1 to start Stage 2. Helmets must be worn whenever riding! (USAC rules apply)
